The French Immersion Program

- 83% to 100% classroom program in French for Grades 1 & 2
- Emphasis on oral communication in Grade 1
- English language instruction is introduced in Grade 3

Spending time at home reading and writing in your child's first language will help to develop strong literacy skills.

Ask your child to explain their FSL learning to you. Modeling second language learning skills is beneficial.

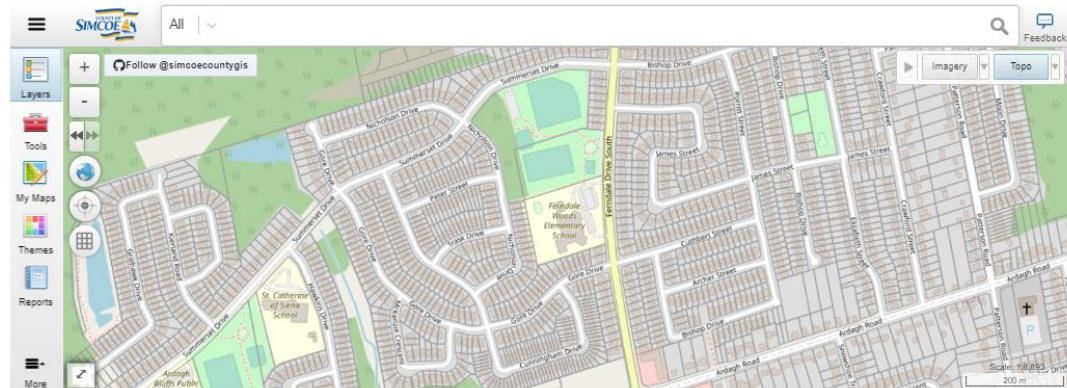

Please note that locations can change and programs may be split between two sites as needed.

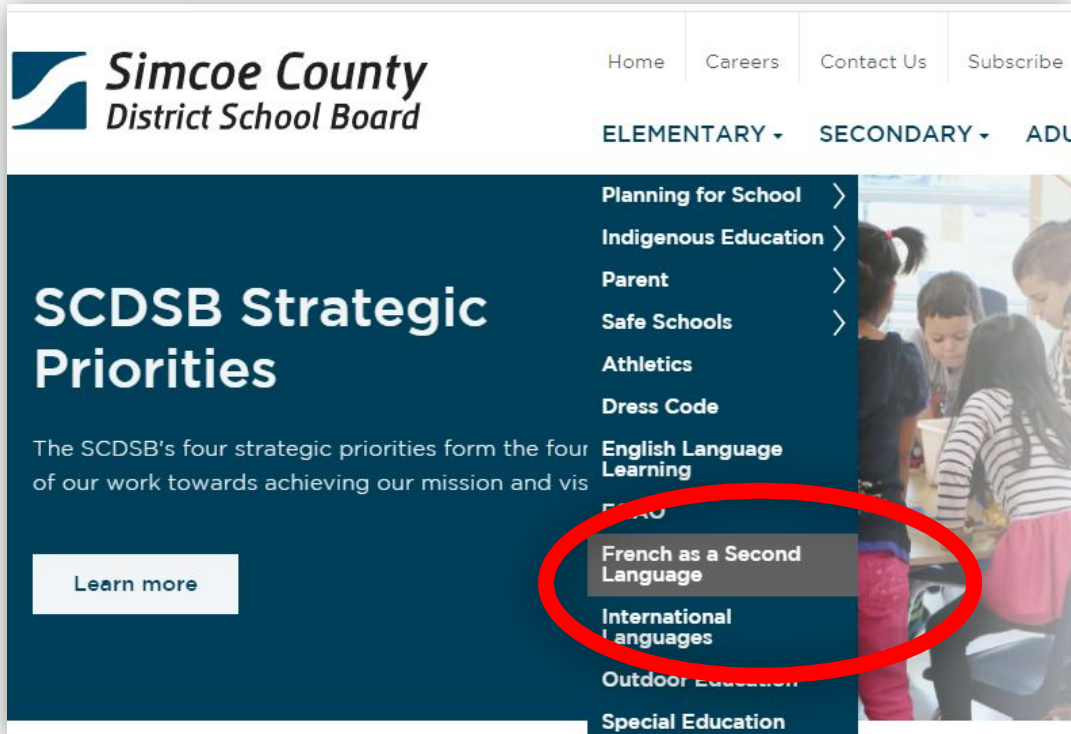
Transportation

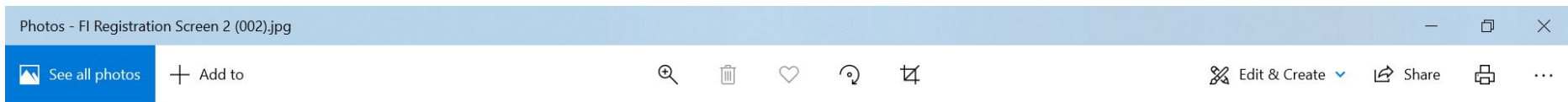
